RACE 1: THE JUNCTION HANDICAP - 1600 Metres

The start of this race was rescheduled to 11:54am due to a requested from Sky Racing.

MOSTLY FORSHOW (NZ) (J. Toeroek) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Held up from the 400m until near the 200m.

FLYING BRANT (J. Murphy) - laid out under pressure in the straight.

RACE 2: ADELAIDE GALVANISING INDUSTRIES HANDICAP - 1600 Metres

The start of this race was rescheduled to 12:28pm due to a requested from Sky Racing.

A SAMURAI MIND (E. Pozman) - rider reported that the gelding had only travelled fairly in the early and middle stages of the event and when placed under pressure near the 700m did not respond to her riding and commenced to weaken from the event from its own accord. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to have cardiac arrhythmia (1st occurrence) and to be lame in the near foreleg (1/5). Co-trainers, Mr. D. Clarken & Ms O. MacGillivray, were advised that he was required to comply with the Racing Australia Code of Practice in order for the gelding to be reinstated to race. Co-trainers were further advised that a Veterinary Clearance would be required prior to a future jump-out, trial or race start.

CASH (J. Stanley) - raced wide without cover throughout the event.

BROWN NOSE DAY GAL (B. King) - hung out under pressure in the straight.

YASUKE (R. Milnes) - raced fiercely in the early and middle stages of the event.



RACE 3: WINNING EDGE PRESENTATIONS MAIDEN PLATE - 1200 Metres

HARRINO (T. Pannell) - slow to begin and shortly after was hampered when tightened onto WHISKEY TUMBLER by TIPTOP TORI.

MACHINEGUN MIKE (J. Holder) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to have tachycardia.

MOUSE IN THE HOUSE (S. Fawke) - slow to begin. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

WHISKEY TUMBLER (R. Milnes) - rider reported that the gelding travelled well in early and middle stages of the event, however when placed under pressure at the entrance to the straight did not respond it had at its only other start.

DRESS TO IMPRESS (J. Stanley) - co-trainers, Mr G. & Mr D. Alexander were reprimanded under AR106(1) for presenting DRESS TO IMPRESS in to race without winkers. As winkers were able to be obtained from another stable and fitted, the mare was permitted to race. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Lost its off fore plate during the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

MALDIVICA (T. Voorham) - rider reported that it was not her intention to lead the event, however after being caught wide in the early stages, she had used her initiative to roll forward and obtain that position rather than restrain in an attempt to gain cover.

ROYAL SWAY (S. Metcalfe) - raced wide without cover throughout the event.

TIPTOP TORI (T. Johnstone) - shifted out on jumping away onto HARRINO.

RACE 4: FLEURIEU MILK COMPANY HANDICAP - 1050 Metres

ALEPPO PINE (L. Currie) - rider could offer no explanation for the disappointing performance. A post-race veterinary examination revealed to have tachycardia and exhibiting signs of a poor recovery. The stable was advised that a Veterinary Clearance would be required prior to a future jump-out, trial or race start.

SHE'S MY EX (J. Stanley) - shifted in on jumping away and bumped SIGNATURE SCENT.

SIGNATURE SCENT (R. Milnes) - inconvenienced on jumping away when bumped by SHE'S MY EX.

FROTHY MACAW (K. Crowther) - raced fiercely in the early and middle stages of the event.

COMMON INTEREST (W. Price) - reared on jumping away and was slow into stride. Raced keenly in the middle stages of the event. Near the 100m was obliged to alter course to the inside of ALEPPO PINE, which shifted out, to obtain clear ground.

RACE 5: SPORTSBET DEQUETTEVILLE STAKES - 1050 Metres

The start of this race was delayed approximately 3 minutes.

CHURCHILL ROSE (T. Johnstone) - inconvenienced on a number of occasions inside the 300m when NOLABELL was contacted and taken out into its running line.

CELESTARIA (W. Price) - near the 300m shifted out to improve and in doing so brushed with NOLABELL on a number of occasions.

NOLABELL (J. Holder) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Inconvenienced on a number occasions when contacted and taken wider by CELESTARIA.



PURE PELT (T. Pannell) - difficult to load. Trainer, Mr T. Doudle, was advised that the filly would now be required to load without delay in an Official Barrier Trial prior to accepting for a future race start.



RACE 6: SPORTSBET ADELAIDE RACING CARNIVAL APRIL 25-MAY 9 HANDICAP (HEAT 4 OF FESTIVAL STATE SPRINT SERIES) - 1100 Metres

ENUFF SEDUCTION (C. Tootell) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Laid out rounding the home turn. Near the 200m was inconvenienced when tightened onto HIGH ON SUGAR by ALAA PLENTY which shifted out. Rider reported that the gelding raced fiercely, took charge and as a result settled further forward than she had anticipated. She further added that in her opinion the gelding raced fresh. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

DECLARED (B. King) - laid out under pressure in the straight and near the 150m shifted out onto CLARENCE. Rider was reprimanded under AR131(a) and advised to straighten her mount quicker in similar circumstances.

ANGEL TORQUE (A. Warren) - near the 900m was momentarily steadied to avoid the heels of WALK LIKE AN ANGEL which shifted in.

CLARENCE (K. Crowther) - inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight. Near the 150m had to be steadied for a number of strides when tightened between COOL MAGNUM which shifted in and DECLARED which shifted out.

HIGH ON SUGAR (J. Toeroek) - lost its off hind plate during the event.

ALAA PLENTY (B. Kennedy) - jumped away awkwardly and shifted out.

COOL MAGNUM (J. Stanley) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Near the 150m shifted in onto CLARENCE. Rider was reminded of his obligations.

BLANC VISAGE (T. Voorham) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

WALK LIKE AN ANGEL (J. Holder) - near the 900m shifted in onto ANGEL TOURQUE which had to be steadied. Rider was reprimanded under AR131(a) and advised of his obligations. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 7: SPORTSBET JOCKEY WATCH HANDICAP - 1522 Metres

TALISAY (R. Milnes) - near the 350m had to take hold and alter course when tightened between FLASH ALICE which shifted in after its hind quarters were turned out and EXTRA HOT which shifted out and away from CHILLCUZ.

CHILLCUZ (A. Warren) - near the 350m shifted out to improve resulting in EXTRA HOT shifting out and away.

EXTRA HOT (D. Tourneur) - near the 350m shifted out and away from CHILLCUZ, which shifted out, onto TALISAY.

FLASH ALICE (B. Kennedy) - near the 350m had its hind quarters contacted by TALISAY resulting in the mare being turned in.

ANAHORISH (K. Crowther) - rider reported that the mare travelled fairly in the early and middle stages of the event however when asked for an effort near the 500m failed to respond to her riding and was disappointing to the finish. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

FRANCE'S BOY (J. Murphy) - underwent a post-race veterinary examination and was deemed suitable to start. Laid in under pressure in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 8: SPORTSBET MATRICE STAKES - 1200 Metres



POWER BEAU (B. Kennedy) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

DIRTY GRIN (NZ) (T. Pannell) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the off hind leg (2/5).



RACE 8: SPORTSBET MATRICE STAKES - 1200 Metres (cont'd)

MT NISEKO (J. Holder) - jumped away awkwardly and was slow to begin. Rider reported that it was his intention to settle further forward, however after the gelding took a step back as the gates were released, he was unable to do so.

RACE 9: SPORTSBET CLARE LINDOP STAKES - 1600 Metres

FREEDOM FLAME (T. Johnstone) - lost its near hind plate during the event.

MATING CALL (E. Finnegan) - shifted in on jumping away and bumped STAR OF OMAHA. Raced fiercely in the early and middle stages of the event. Rider reported that the filly was not suited to the slow tempo of the race.

DIRTY OLD TOWN (J. Holder) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

OAK PARK MADDISON (C. Tootell) - slow to begin.

SILVASISTA (R. Milnes) - slow to begin. Laid out under pressure in the straight. Rider reported after being slow to begin, she had found herself further back than she had hoped. She further added that the filly travelled well in the early and middle stages however was not suited by the slow tempo and when asked for an effort, she was unable to make up ground. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

KAKADU SUNSET (J. Stanley) - rider reported that inside the 200m the filly commenced to give ground, and he had become concerned with its action behind. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

STAR OF OMAHA (W. Price) - inconvenienced when contacted by MATING CALL on jumping away.

SYNTHESISE (K. Crowther) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Held up from the 500m until near the 300m.

SHE'S STARGAZING (J. Noonan) - near the 200m shifted out onto SILENT ANSWER which had to be steadied when tightened onto BIG RITA JUNE. Rider was reprimanded under AR131(a) and to take greater care in future.

BIG RITA JUNE (A. Stead) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed the mare to have small lacerations on the off hind leg. First aid administered.

FRINGES (NZ) (J. Murphy) - difficult to load. Trainer, Mr M. Hickmott, was advised a warning had been placed on the filly.

SILENT ANSWER (J. Opperman) - near the 200m had to be steadied when tightened on to BIG RITA JUNE by SHE'S STARGAZING which shifted out.

RACE 10: AIG SECURITY HANDICAP - 1200 Metres

DOBBINAIR (J. Toeroek) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

GOLD SPIRIT (B. King) - laid out rounding the home turn.

SYNCHRO (NZ) (T. Pannell) - had difficulty obtaining clear ground from the entrance to the straight until approaching the 200m.

ICE SYMPHONY (T. Johnstone) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Held up from the 500m until near the 200m.

THE JOURNO (T. Voorham) - slow to begin. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

GRINZINGER ACE (D. Caboche) - slow to begin.

ARTISSI (S. Metcalfe) - inconvenienced near the 800m by CASINO SHOWGIRL.

RACE 10:AIG SECURITY HANDICAP - 1200 Metres (cont'd)

CASINO SHOWGIRL (K. Crowther) - raced fiercely in the early and middle stages of the event. Near the 800m shifted out taking ARTISSI wider on the track. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

GLOBAL TURN (C. Murtagh) - acting on confirmed advice from. Mr K. Stokes, representing trainer, Mr P. Stokes, that the mare was lame in the near foreleg and would be unfit to start, Stewards declared GLOBAL TURN a late scratching at 8:30am. Trainer, Mr P. Stokes, was advised that a Veterinary Clearance would be required prior to a future jump-out, trial or race start.

GENERAL:

Trainer, Mr H. Dwyer, was reprimanded under LR11.4.4 for failing to notify Racing SA Integrity department of their horse's travel arrangements as required.
