RACE 1: SPORTSBET JOCKEY WATCH HANDICAP - 2426 Metres

The start of this event was rescheduled to begin at 12:08pm owing to a request from Sky Racing.

CRIMSON VINE (NZ) (J. Holder) - raced keenly in the early stages of the event. Rider reported that the gelding travelled well in the early and middle stages of the event, however when placed under pressure did not respond to his riding. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a slower than expected recovery.

HIGH SOCIETY GIRL (NZ) (R. Milnes) - near the entrance to the straight was disappointed for a run between CRIMSON VINE (NZ) and HARSH, resulting in HIGH SOCIETY GIRL (NZ) becoming held up until approaching the 200m and shifted out to obtain clear running. Lost its off hind plate during the event.

SMILING ASSASSIN (K. Crowther) - laid out under pressure over the concluding stages of the event.

HARLEY'N'ROSE (I. Sit) - near the 1000m, when the race tempo quickened, became awkwardly placed on the heels of JACKSON RUN for a short distance and lost ground.

JACKSON RUN (T. Hutchinson) - laid out in the straight.

SHADOW HAWK (NZ) (C. Tootell) - jumped away awkwardly.

ALEKHINE'S GUN (A. Goindasamy) - jumped away awkwardly.

RACE 2: SPORTSBET BLACKBOOK MAIDEN PLATE - 1000 Metres

MOUSE IN THE HOUSE (A. Goindasamy) - following the declaration of acceptances trainer, Ms L. Treloar, made a gear application to remove the nasal strip from the gelding's race gear. Stewards acceded to this request and acting under AR206(2) reprimanded Ms L. Treloar. Jumped away awkwardly, shifted out and contacted VIA NICCOLINA.

SCOOPED (NZ) (T. Pannell) - jumped away awkwardly.

WOODYWIN (R. Milnes) - lost its near fore plate during the event.

BILK (T. Hutchinson) - on jumping away shifted in onto JUST COMET.

GO ASK ALICE (I. Sit) - raced wide without cover throughout the event. Approaching the 300m was hampered when tightened onto VIA NICCOLINA by OLIVIA MARIE which shifted out and as a result lost its position.

JUST COMET (B. King) - on jumping away was tightened onto WOODYWIN by BILK which shifted in and as a result lost its position.

OLIVIA MARIE (L. Stojakovic) - jumped away awkwardly. Approaching the 300m shifted out onto GO ASK ALICE tightening that mare onto VIA NICCOLINA. Rider was reprimanded under AR131(a) and advised she must be sufficiently clear when shifting ground in future. Rider reported that it was her intention to settle further forward however owing to how the mare jumped way and the formation of the field, she elected to restrain in the early stages in an attempt to gain cover.

STORMFORGE (J. Holder) - jumped away awkwardly. Rider reported that the colt raced greenly throughout the event.

VIA NICCOLINA (C. Tootell) - on jumping away was contacted by MOUSE IN THE HOUSE which shifted out. Rider reported that the mare raced greenly throughout the event.

RACE 3: SPORTSBET RACE PREVIEWS HANDICAP - 1000 Metres

ANGEL TORQUE (T. Hutchinson) - jumped away awkwardly. Laid out in the straight. Rider explained that in her opinion the mare did not handle today's track conditions. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

BASSETT BABE (J. Holder) - jumped away awkwardly.

RACE 4: THOMAS FARMS HANDICAP - 1000 Metres

INTELLECTUAL (J. Toeroek) - on jumping away was contacted by STAND ALONE which shifted in.

BOHEMIAN ANGEL (N. Callow) - jumped away awkwardly.

STAND ALONE (B. King) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted in and contacted INTELLECTUAL.

SUMMERTIME MADNESS (C. Murtagh) - slow to begin. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Near the 900m when racing keenly became awkwardly placed on the heels of TOGETHERFOREVER and shifted out.

TORNADO'S SISTER (S. Metcalfe) - jumped away awkwardly and shifted out.





RACE 5: HAHN HANDICAP – 1569 Metres

NICISH (B. King) – laid out under pressure in the straight. Inside the 200m when laying out, brushed with TYUSIX.

CANNY DEFENSE (S. Metcalfe) – jumped away awkwardly. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

EXTINGUISH (NZ) (T. Pannell) – jumped away awkwardly. Rider could offer no explanation for the disappointing performance. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the near hind leg (1/5). Trainer, Mr M. Hickmott, was advised that a Veterinary Clearance would be required prior to a future jump-out, trial or race start.

ROGUE WARRIOR (J. Holder) – on arrival on course underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was deemed suitable to start.

TYUSIX (S. Ingelse) – rider explained that it was her instructions to settle mid-field in today's event, however when the mare was caught wide without cover in the early stages she elected to roll forward and obtain a position outside the leader.

FULL COMMITMENT (H. Grace) – lost its near fore plate during the event.

GEETEE FORTY (I. Sit) – slow to begin. Laid out in the straight. Rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR132(7)(a)(i) in that he used his whip in consecutive strides prior to the 100m and was reprimanded.

RACE 6: SPORTSBET GREEN TICK HANDICAP – 1000 Metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately 3 minutes owing to SASSY LITTLE MISS was required to be re-plated.

FROM THE BLOCK (C. Murtagh) – jumped away awkwardly and shifted in onto SQUAD. Laid out in under pressure in the straight.

EXPERT WITNESS (A. Goindasamy) – reared on jumping away and as a result was slow to begin. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

UP THE DEN (T. Pannell) – jumped away awkwardly.

SQUAD (T. Hutchinson) – jumped away awkwardly and shortly after was tightened between NOSTRYIA and FROM THE BLOCK and as a result lost its position. Raced wide without cover throughout the event.

SASSY LITTLE MISS (C. Tootell) – lost its off fore plate enroute to the barriers and required to be re-plated on arrival at the barriers. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was deemed suitable to start. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

UPTOWN MONK (K. Crowther) – fractious in its barrier as the start was affected and as a result was slow to begin. Rider could offer no explanation in relation to the disappointing performance. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

NOSTRYIA (J. Holder) – jumped away awkwardly.

ZOUTRAIL (C. Munro) – held up for clear running from the 400m until the entrance to the straight and was then momentarily disappointed for a run between SQUAD and NOSTRYIA.

Correct weight was delayed to allow Starters and Stewards to view the vision of the start.

RACE 7: PFD FOOD SERVICES HANDICAP – 1250 Metres

The start of this event was rescheduled to begin at 3:40pm owing to a request from Sky Racing.

DANCING STORM (N. Callow) – approaching the winning post raced in restricted room between HELLO WORLD and THE COSMIC ONE which shifted out and as a result had to be steadied.





RACE 7: PFD FOOD SERVICES HANDICAP - 1250 Metres (cont'd)

EUGENIUS (R. Milnes) - near the 1100m was steadied when tightened for room between DANCING STORM and THE COSMIC ONE which both shifted ground and as a result lost its position. Momentarily held up approaching the 200m.

AUTUMN FROST (J. Toeroek) - jumped away awkwardly and shifted in onto ORTHIE'S BOY. Rider reported that the gelding travelled only fairly throughout the event and proved disappointing. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

THE COSMIC ONE (B. Price) - raced wide without cover throughout the event. Approaching the winning post shifted out into the running line of DANCING STORM which had to be steadied. Rider was severely reprimanded under AR131(a) for Careless Riding and advised to make a greater effort in keeping his mounts straight.

COOL MAGNUM (S. Ingelse) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

ORTHIE'S BOYS (W. Price) - on jumping away was hampered when tightened onto HELLO WORLD by AUTUMN FROST which shifted in and as a result lost its position.

INVERTATIONAL (T. Hutchinson) - slow to begin.

BREAKFAST (J. Holder) - rider reported that in his opinion the mare did not handle today's track conditions.

RACE 8: FESTIVAL HIRE HANDICAP - 1250 Metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately 2 minutes to avoid a delay with an interstate event.

EMBELLISHER (J. Holder) - jumped away awkwardly. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages. Raced wide without cover throughout the event.

SILVER LIFESTYLE (L. Stojakovic) - rider reported that the gelding never travelled throughout the event and proved disappointing. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the off hind (2/5). Trainer, Mr F. Smith, was advised that a Veterinary Clearance would be required prior to a future jump-out, trial or race start.

STEEL TSUNAMI (T. Hutchinson) - dipped on jumping away. Rider reported that in her opinion the gelding did not handle today's track conditions.

HYSTERICAL LADY (H. Grace) - jumped away awkwardly and as a result was slow to begin. Rider explained that the mare had difficulty maintaining contact with the body of the field despite his efforts in the early and middle stages. He added from inside the 600m HYSTERICAL LADY grabbed the bit, improved into the event and finished off strongly.

SUPER SHARP (S. Metcalfe) - rider was reminded of her obligations under AR132(6)(c) in relation to using her whip when out of contention. Lost its near hind plate during the event.

IMPENDING DIAMOND (S. Logan) - slow to begin.

RACE 9: QUAYCLEAN HANDICAP - 1400 Metres

HARD PRINCE (J. Toeroek) - jumped away awkwardly and as a result was slow to begin.

BIG SUE (K. Crowther) - raced wide without cover throughout the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

BOLD SECRET (N. Callow) - near the 800m improved onto the heels of HOT STRUT, had to be steadied and shifted out, taking CIELAO wider. Rider explained that in his opinion the gelding did not handle today's track conditions. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

CIELAO (T. Pannell) - jumped away awkwardly. Near the 800m was taken wider by BOLD SECRET which shifted out.



RACE 9: QUAYCLEAN HANDICAP - 1400 Metres (cont'd)

TAPINFORPAR (I. Sit) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages. Raced wide without cover throughout the event. Laid in under pressure in the straight. Approaching the 300m when laying in, became momentarily awkward on the heels of CIELAO which rolled out.

HARD LEAF (H. Grace) - laid in, in the straight.
