Report on Race Meeting held at Glenburnie
Racecourse by the Mount Gambier Racing Club on
Friday, 7 August 2026

RACE 1: MIDFIELD MEATS MAIDEN PLATE - 900 Metres

CALM THE PRESS (C. Rawiller) - jumped away awkwardly. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Rider explained that in his opinion the gelding did not handle today's track conditions and being back in distance.

DAISY DREAMING (K. Crowther) - jumped away awkwardly and shortly after was bumped by NORTHERN GOLD.

MAI (K. Walters) - laid out under pressure in the straight.

THE MUSCLE (M. Collett) - laid in under pressure in the straight. Rider reported that the gelding raced greenly throughout the event.

HELLFIRE JESS (H. Grace) - jumped away awkwardly.

NORTHERN GOLD (D. Caboche) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted in and bumped DAISY DREAMING.



RACE 2: THE BORDER WATCH MAIDEN PLATE - 1300 Metres

BLACKHILL BOY (C. Rawiller) - in the vicinity of the 500m was taken out onto PRINCESS CHIC when attempting a neat run to the outside of MYCHEMICALROMANCE which laid out.

MYCHEMICALROMANZE (A. Stead) - laid out under pressure from the 600m and in the vicinity of the 500m, while laying out despite the effort by its rider, tightening the running of BLACKHILL BOY.

PRINCE PRESTIGIOUS (J. Hill) - raced wide without cover throughout the event. Laid in under pressure in the straight. Rider explained that he had been caught wide in the early and middle stages of the event however his instructions were to have the gelding where comfortable and in his opinion PRINCE PRESTIGIOUS was disappointing to the finish. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

BALLROOM BLAST (K. Crowther) - bumped on jumping away by WHERE'S BEN.

PRINCESS CHIC (C. Tootell) - In the vicinity of the 500m was hampered for a number of strides between BLACKHILL BOY which was taken out and PEYTON JANE (NZ) which laid in marginally. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SPOTLIGHT ON CURLY (M. Julius) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

PEYTON JANE (NZ) (K. Walters) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. In the vicinity of the 500m laid in marginally and had its hind quarters turned for a number of strides when contacted by PRINCESS CHIC.

WHERE'S BEN (S. Robbins) - shifted out on jumping away and bumped BALLROOM BLAST. Raced wide without cover for majority of the event.

RACE 3: MINROSA RATING 0 - 54 HANDICAP - 900 Metres

ZUETORO (J. Gutte) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

CRACKLE 'N' BURN (A. Stead) - following the declaration of acceptances trainer, Mr L. Williams, made a gear application to remove blinkers and tongue from the gelding's race gear. Stewards acceded to this request. On arrival on course underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was deemed suitable to start.

NANKEEN (H. Grace) - reared as the start was affected and as a result was slow to begin (approximately 4 lengths). Trainer, Ms B. O'Loughlin, was advised that a warning had been placed on the gelding in relation to its barrier manners.

EMMOOKI MAGIC (C. Tootell) - shortly after the start was tightened between ZUETORO, which shifted out, and TANNA. Laid in under pressure over the concluding 200m.

SHOOTING FOR STARS (S. Robbins) - laid out under pressure over the concluding 200m.

UNLIMITED ABILITY (K. Walters) - on arrival on course underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was deemed suitable to start.

RACE 4: SPORTSBET BENCHMARK 58 HANDICAP - 2050 Metres

SIDE PIECE (NZ) (T. Madden) - slow to begin. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

WIMMERA STAR (C. Rawiller) - laid out approaching the finish resulting in its rider having to correct the gelding. Rider was reprimanded under AR132(6)(b) in relation to using his whip in an action that raises the rider's arm above shoulder height.

PIANTA (K. Walters) - raced wide without cover throughout the event.

DODGY ELEMENT (A. Warren) - rider was reprimanded under AR131(b) in that she failed to ride her mount out to the finish of the race. Stewards were comfortably satisfied that it did not alter the final placings.



RACE 5: GREEN TRIANGLE LIVESTOCK & REAL ESTATE RATING 0 - 54 HANDICAP - 1300 Metres

DETNAW (L. Stojakovic) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted in and bumped SO GRAND.

LAPILLI (C. Tootell) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted out and hampered OUR ELLIE ROSE (NZ). Inside the 1000m was eased to avoid the heels of OUR ELLIE ROSE (NZ) which shifted in. Raced keenly in the middle stages of the event. In the vicinity of the 500m improved onto the heels of OUR ELLIE ROSE (NZ) and had to be eased. Rider explained that after having to be eased inside the 1000m, LAPILLI commenced to race keenly and in her opinion, this was detrimental to the mare's chances to finish the race off strongly. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

BAD TO THE BONE (A. Stone) - inside the 1000m was eased to avoid the heels of LAPILLI.

MELISSA KATE (NZ) (K. Walters) - jumped away awkwardly. Raced fiercely in the early and middle stages of the event.

ROYAL TELEPHONE (D. Caboche) - rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR132(7)(a)(ii) in that he used his whip on more than five occasions prior to the 100m and was suspended from riding in races for a period to commence midnight Friday, 14 August 2026 and to conclude midnight Wednesday, 19 August 2026, a period of 2 meetings. In determining penalty, Stewards had regard for the totality of the use of the whip by D. Caboche and noted that he used his whip on three occasions over the last 100 metres.

URBANISE (J. Gutte) - raced wide without cover throughout the event.

SO GRAND (A. Warren) - jumped away awkwardly and bumped DETNAW.

OUR ELLIE ROSE (NZ) (S. Field) - hampered on jumping away by LAPILLI which shifted out. Inside the 1000m shifted in, tightening the running of LAPILLI which had to be eased. Rider was severely reprimanded under AR131(a) and advised in future to only shift ground when entitled to do so.

RACE 6: O'CONNOR & GRANEY BENCHMARK 56 HANDICAP - 1550 Metres

BIT OF A REBEL (A. Stone) - lost its off fore plate during the event.

HIDDEN BOUNTY (K. Crowther) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

SURFY PETE (T. Madden) - rider explained that the gelding travelled well in the early and middle stages of the event however did not respond to his riding from the vicinity of the 500m and for this reason he elected to not place SURFY PETE under pressure over the concluding stages. He further added that in his opinion the gelding did not handle the heavy track conditions. Stable representative for trainer, Mr P. Preusker, was advised a warning had been placed on the gelding. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

AKITU (D. Caboche) - slow to begin.

AHVEJAY (C. Tootell) - slow to begin.

UNIQUE POET (C. Rawiller) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages. Hung out throughout the event. Trainer, Mr J. Post, was advised a warning had been placed on the gelding in relation to its racing manners. Eased down over the final 100m. Rider explained that he had become concerned with the gelding's action after it shifted out abruptly inside the 400m and for this reason he elected to ease UNIQUE POET out of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

TALLAPOOSA (J. Hill) - laid out under pressure in the straight. In the vicinity of the 100m hung out across the heels of LIMOSA(NZ) and had to be eased.



RACE 7: SCOTT GROUP OF COMPANIES BENCHMARK 62 HANDICAP - 1200 Metres

HALLIWELL (NZ) (M. Julius) - slow to begin. Rider explained that her instructions were to find cover from the wide gate. After being slow away and the formation of the field to her inside, she was of the opinion her best option to find cover was at the rear of the field and not be caught wide. She further added HALLIWELL (NZ) travelled very well throughout the event and when asked to improve inside the 500m, the mare finished the race off strongly.

SHOUT ME (J. Hill) - shortly after the start shifted out and tightened the running of GUSTY WAY. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. In the vicinity of the 800m was tightened onto THE GUAVA when attempting to improve to the outside of STOOPS which shifted out. Laid out in the straight. In the vicinity of the 300m shifted out and away from AQUAHOLIC. In the vicinity of the 250m shifted out, tightening the running of FROSTY NIGHT. Rider was reprimanded under AR131(a) and advised to stop riding his mount sooner on this occasion. Rider did not ride the gelding out over the concluding 100m in his normal manner. Rider explained that the gelding only travelled fairly throughout the event however when placed under pressure from the 500m began to lay out and inside the 200m SHOUT ME hung out, and for this reason he elected to ease the gelding down over the final 100m. Co-trainer, Mr K. Post, a warning had been placed on the gelding in relation to its racing manners. Mr K. Post advised Stewards on 10 August, that SHOUT ME pulled up well and they will continue with the geldings preparation as planned.

GUSTY WAY (H. Grace) - shortly after the start was tightened onto THE GUAVA by SHOUT ME which shifted out.

NARALINGA (K. Crowther) - slow into stride. In the vicinity of the 800m was taken out by FROSTY NIGHT.

BANCOORA (C. Rawiller) - laid out throughout the event. Held up rounding the home turn.

TERRALIGHT (T. Madden) - held up for clear running rounding the home turn.

FROSTY NIGHT (S. Field) - in the vicinity of the 800m was hampered and taken out across the heels of AQUAHOLIC by THE GUAVA onto NARALINGA. In the vicinity of the 250m was tightened and lost its position between BANCOORA and SHOUT ME which shifted out.

MIN KIATA (K. Walters) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

STOOPS (A. Stone) - laid out throughout the event. In the vicinity of the 800m shifted out tightening the running of SHOUT ME, taking that gelding out. Rider was reprimanded under AR131(a) and advised to straighten her mount sooner than she did on this occasion.

THE GUAVA (C. Tootell) - in the vicinity of the 800m was hampered and taken out onto FROSTY NIGHT by SHOUT ME.

General:

J. Hill was reprimanded under AR128(2) for leaving the course without permission from the Stewards following the running of Race 7.
