RACE 1: M & C KNOWLES PAINTER & DECORATOR MAIDEN PLATE - 900 Metres

TARIN'S ROCK (K. Walters) - slow to begin.

HABONDIA (H. Grace) - inconvenienced on jumping away by STAND ALONE, which began awkwardly, and as a result shifted in and tightened MEADOWS FLYER onto WRITTEN BY BETSY.

MAI (C. Puls) - began awkwardly and lost ground. Raced greenly for the majority of the event.

WRITTEN BY BETSY (M. Collett) - contacted shortly after the start by MEADOWS FLYER.

MEADOWS FLYER (D. Tourneur) - inconvenienced at the start when tightened by HABONDIA onto WRITTEN BY BETSY.

BELLA ANGELICA (W. Price) - shifted ground when placed under pressure in the straight.



RACE 1: M & C KNOWLES PAINTER & DECORATOR MAIDEN PLATE - 900 Metres (cont'd)

STAND ALONE (B. King) - began awkwardly, shifted in and inconvenienced HABONDIA.

RACE 2: GREEN TRIANGLE LIVESTOCK & REAL ESTATE MAIDEN PLATE - 1200 Metres

MISTER SOLLY (T. Madden) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

UNIQUE POET (C. Rawiller) - steadied near the 800m to avoid the heels of TERRALIGHT, which lost ground in front of it.

ET TU KIRKLISTON (A. Goindasamy) - near the 1000m shifted in when insufficiently clear of ZARUBINA, resulting in that horse making contact with TAAJWAR, which became unbalanced. Rider pleaded guilty to a charge of careless riding under AR131(a) and was suspended from riding in races for a period to commence midnight Sunday, 14 June 2026 to conclude midnight Wednesday, 24 June 2026, a period of three meetings.

TAAJWAR (A. Warren) - near the 1000m was contacted by ZARUBINA and became unbalanced.

SERILO (D. Caboche) - acting on advice from trainer, Mr J. Searle, that he was experiencing transport difficulties and the mare would not be on course in time for its race Stewards declared SERILO a late scratching at 9.28am.

ZARUBINA (B. King) - near the 1000m was steadied to avoid the heels of ET TU KIRKLISTON, which shifted in, and as a result made contact with TAAJWAR.

FLYING NIC (T. Cameron) - acting on advice from trainer, Mr A. Bobbin, that the filly had injured itself on the float and would be unable to start Stewards declared FLYING NIC a late scratching at 9.04am.

TERRALIGHT (W. Price) - rider reported that near the 800m the filly became unbalanced and blundered.

RACE 3: I & D TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT CLASS ONE PLATE - 2050 Metres

ALEKHINE'S GUN (B. King) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination on arrival on course as it had raced in the previous seven days and was deemed suitable to start.

DONAM (S. Terachi) - raced wide without cover for the majority of the event.

PIANTA (K. Walters) - raced wide without cover from the 800m.


RHINESTONE RORY (C. Rawiller) - rider was unable to offer any explanation for the gelding's performance. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

OTTO'S DREAM (T. Hutchinson) - momentarily held up near the 400m behind RHINESTONE RORY, which was weakening.

EMPRESS OF SOUL (A. Warren) - rider reported that the mare may not have handled today's heavy track conditions. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a poor recovery rate and tachycardia. Trainer, Mr G. Boyce, was advised that a Veterinary Clearance would be required prior to a future jump-out, trial or race start.

HASTA LA OINKERS (D. Caboche) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

RACE 4: SCOTT GROUP OF COMPANIES BENCHMARK 66 HANDICAP - 1200 Metres



EUGENIUS (J. Gutte) - slow to begin approximately three lengths. Trainer, Mr M. McClean, was advised that a warning had been placed on the gelding. Rider reported that after being slow to begin she urged the gelding along in the early stages and it then began to race keenly for some distance.



RACE 4: SCOTT GROUP OF COMPANIES BENCHMARK 66 HANDICAP - 1200 Metres (cont'd)

EL PASO CITIE (C. Rawiller) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SHOUT ME (D. Tourneur) - difficult to load. Co-trainers, Messrs B. and K. Post, were advised that a warning had been placed on the gelding.

KARASMATIC (NZ) (K. Walters) - raced fiercely in the early and middle stages of the event, and near the 900m got its head up and became awkward on heels.

RACE 5: BLUE LAKE BAR & BISTRO RATING 0 - 54 HANDICAP - 1200 Metres

RATNARAJ (D. Tourneur) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

THE MARINER (NZ) (C. MacRedmond) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination on arrival on course as it had raced in the previous seven days and was deemed suitable to start.

MELISSA KATE (NZ) (K. Walters) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Raced wide without cover from the 1000m.

LONGWARRY (D. Caboche) - raced wide without cover from the 1000m.

RACE 6: CARLTON DRAUGHT HARD RATED BENCHMARK 58 HANDICAP - 1800 Metres

GIDDY UP BANKCHECK (NZ) (A. Stead) - raced in restricted room near the 900m and was eased.

MR TRAFFICANTI (NZ) (T. Hutchinson) - rider could not offer any explanation for the gelding's performance. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

AFFAIRE VUE (D. Tourneur) - raced wide without cover for the majority of the event. Rider explained that in his opinion the mare did not handle today's track conditions and may not have been suited by the distance of the race. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

ELSIE GIRL (D. Caboche) - began awkwardly and lost ground. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

RACE 7: SPORTSBET BENCHMARK 58 HANDICAP - 1400 Metres

IN THAT MODE (J. Murphy) - rider reported that the gelding did not travel throughout the event and proved disappointing when placed under pressure. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SHADDAP (A. Warren) - slow to begin.


SUPREME THUNDER (J. Opperman) - held up over the concluding stages of the event and was not fully tested to the finish.

I AM RALPH (D. Tourneur) - raced keenly in the middle stages of the event.

HIGH GARDEN (B. King) - rider reported that the mare did not handle today's track conditions.

AMBUSHED (A. Stead) - near the 400m was held up and lost ground behind SWEATER GIRL, which was weakening.

RACE 8: O'CONNOR & GRANEY RATING 0 - 56 HANDICAP - 1550 Metres



TOES IN FIRST (C. Rawiller) - rider explained that in his opinion the gelding may not have handled today's heavy track conditions. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 8: O'CONNOR & GRANNEY RATING 0 - 56 HANDICAP - 1550 Metres (cont'd)

BELLE FROM HELL (T. Hutchinson) - rider explained that in her opinion the mare may be better suited when ridden further back. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

GRINZINGER JOY (NZ) (A. Goindasamy) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

DORA AURORA (A. Warren) - raced wide without cover from the 1000m.
