Report on Race Meeting held at Glenburnie
Racecourse by the Millicent Racing Club on Sunday,
22 March 2026

RACE 1: SOMERSET HOTEL MAIDEN HANDICAP - 900 Metres

WHATHAPPENSINVEGAS (L. Williams) - slow to begin. Laid out rounding the home turn and in the straight.

REBEL JEN (C. Puls) - slow to begin.

RUNAWAY LOVE (D. Tourneur) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was deemed suitable to start. Fractious in the barriers. Raced keenly in the early stages of the event.

DIVINE REINE (T. Johnstone) - held up from the 500m until the 300m.

RACE 2: BOWMAN EARTHMOVERS MAIDEN PLATE - 1400 Metres

DALI'S PICASSO (T. Madden) - approaching the 400m its hind quarters were bumped by FIORENTE RULES which was taken out by TAAJWAR.

DURHAM (J. Hill) - shifted in approaching the winning post momentarily tightening TAAJWAR.

SPICY APPLE (N. Farley) - held up momentarily near the 200m.

TAAJWAR (T. Johnstone) - approaching the 400m shifted out when insufficiently clear of FIORENTE RULES, tightening that mare onto DALI'S PICASSO which resulted in FIORENTE RULES having to be steadied and lose its rightful running. Rider pleaded guilty to a charge of Careless Riding under AR131(a) and was suspended from riding in races for a period to commence midnight Saturday, 28 March 2026 and to conclude midnight Friday, 04 April 2026, a period of 3 meetings. Had to be eased approaching the winning post away from the heels of DURHAM.

FIORENTE RULES (R. Milnes) - approaching the 400m had to be steadied when taken out by TAAJWAR and tightened onto DALI'S PICASSO resulting in the mare losing its rightful running.

HIGH ALTITUDE (C. Jones) - slow to begin. Raced wide without cover for majority of the event.



RACE 3: DIGIORGIO FAMILY WINES CLASS ONE PLATE - 2050 Metres

PIANTA (K. Walters) - began awkwardly.

RYAN WAYNE (NZ) (C. Puls) - raced wide without cover for majority of the event.

HELIOSON (W. Gordon) - rider was unable to offer an explanation in relation to the gelding's performance. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

HASTA LA OINKERS (D. Caboche) - slow to begin.

MAI TIME (C. Munro) - finished a distant last. Trainer, Mr S. McIntyre, was advised a warning had been placed on the mare in relation to it being uncompetitive.

RACE 4: SQUIB GROUP BENCHMARK 66 HANDICAP - 1200 Metres

ALLINTHETIMING (W. Gordon) - got its head up shortly after the start when being restrained to obtain a position close to the rail.

SILVER CLIFF (T. Johnstone) - fractious in the barriers. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and deemed suitable to start. As the mare damaged its barrier gate when being fractious, it started from one gate wider.

LONELY ONE (B. King) - began awkwardly and got its head up. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SYMPHONITE (H. Grace) - raced wide without cover from the 900m.

RACE 5: MAC FORD & MILLICENT MAZDA RATING 0 - 56 HANDICAP - 900 Metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately 4 minutes as YOURAWAY and NOBLE NIGHTCRAWLER (NZ) required a pre-race veterinary examination on arrival at the barriers.

CAPITALEX (J. Gutte) - contacted at the start by NOBLE NIGHTCRAWLER.

YOURAWAY (J. Opperman) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was deemed suitable to start. Slow to begin. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the mare to be lame in the near foreleg (3/5). Trainer, Mr J. Opperman, was advised that a Veterinary Clearance would be required prior to a future jump-out, trial or race start.

NOBLE NIGHTCRAWLER (R. Milnes) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was deemed suitable to start. Began awkwardly, shifted in and made contact with CAPITALEX.

JUST WAI (D. Tourneur) - slow to begin. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

RACE 6: JOHN CHAY & CO MILLICENT CUP - 2050 Metres

UNSEEN RULER (NZ) (J. Hill) - rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR132(7)(a)(ii) in that he used his whip on more than five occasions prior to the 100m and was fined \$100.

VINTAGE KOD (IRE) (B. King) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages. Raced wide without cover for majority of the event.

HASTA LA PRINCE (D. Tourneur) - tightened shortly the start between VINTAGE KOD (IRE) and LUDO (NZ) which began awkwardly and shifted out.

LUDO (NZ) (H. Grace) - began awkwardly, shifted out and tightened HASTA LA PRINCE onto VINTAGE KOD (IRE). Raced keenly in the early stages of the event. Worked forward from the 1600m to obtain the lead near the 1300m. Finished a distant last. Trainer, Mr S. McIntyre, was advised a warning had been placed on the gelding in relation to being uncompetitive.

RACE 7: NUTRIEN AG SOLUTIONS MILLICENT RATING 0 - 54 HANDICAP - 1200 Metres

FOREVER WAITING (K. Crowther) - laid in under pressure in the straight.

MELISSA KATE (NZ) (K. Walters) - raced wide without cover for majority of the event.

PRIZE LAD (D. Caboche) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was deemed suitable to start.

OUR ELLIE ROSE (NZ) (H. Grace) - raced wide without cover for majority of the event.

RACE 8: MAYURA STATION BENCHMARK 56 HANDICAP - 1550 Metres

BANCOORA (J. Hill) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

TRIPLE OH (NZ) (H. Grace) - held up from the 550m until the 400m.

OUR SASSY LADY (NZ) (J. Murphy) - began awkwardly and lost ground. Rider explained that after being slow to begin, the mare settled back than expected.

AUSSIE PHAROAH (K. Walters) - raced wide without cover for majority of the event. Laid in rounding the home turn and in the straight

The front gates of barrier 11 were damaged in Race 4 and was unable to be repaired. Consequently barrier 11 was left vacant for the remaining races.
