RACE 1: GREAT NORTHERN LODGE/REX DAVIES CRASH REPAIRS/CROMBIE'S BULK
HAULAGE/FLINDERS RANGES BUTCHERS MAIDEN - 1200 Metres

CAESOUR'S TOMB (J. Gutte) - slow to begin.

SHARE THE FIZZ (J. Kerr) - raced wide without cover throughout the event.

RACE 1: GREAT NORTHERN LODGE/REX DAVIES CRASH REPAIRS/CROMBIE'S BULK
HAULAGE/FLINDERS RANGES BUTCHERS MAIDEN - 1200 Metres (cont'd)

Correct weight for this event was delayed to allow J. Gutte (CAESOUR'S TOMB) to make a submission to the Stewards for her mount to be declared a non-runner on the grounds that her barrier was delayed in opening resulting in her mount being slow to begin. After considering evidence from J. Gutte, and barrier attendant Ms L. McKenzie, viewing the vision and acting on their own observations Stewards declared CAESOUR'S TOMB a non-runner under AR204(1)(c) and ordered that all monies invested on CAESOUR'S TOMB be refunded, and that all successful wagers be subjected to a deduction of 21c for the win and 21c for a place.

RACE 2: TRANSCONTINENTAL HOTEL, QUORN / QUANDONG CAFÉ, QUORN / BURY
PLUMBING / FLINDERS SUPPLIES BM 58 HANDICAP - 1200 Metres

Prior to the running of Race 2 the barriers were tested to ensure that barrier stall six would open simultaneously with the remainder of the field. After testing the barriers Stewards, in conjunction with the Starter, Mr W. Kerford, elected to not use barrier stall six for Race 2 until they could be comfortably satisfied that the stall would open effectively.

BRULLEN (S. Wright) - reluctant to proceed to the start. Trainer, Mr D. Page, was advised that a warning had been placed on the gelding.

FOOTPRINTS (NZ) (W. Cave) - passing the 800m raced in restricted room between RAYMOND'S REWARD and ONE KIND and became awkwardly placed on the heels of ONE KIND and as a result had to be momentarily steadied.

RAYMOND'S REWARD (M. Henderson) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to have bled from both nostrils. Trainer, Mr T. Montgomerie, was advised that as this was the gelding's first bi-lateral bleed RAYMOND'S REWARD would now be suspended from racing for a period of three months in accordance with AR79(4) and would be required to have the gelding reinstated in accordance with AR79(4)(b) prior to a future race.

OUR BEAU (NZ) (A. Stone) - rider reported that the gelding raced with a bounding action throughout the event.

After the running of Race 2, Stewards were satisfied that barrier stall six had opened with the field and therefore proceeded to load in that stall for the remaining races.

RACE 3: SALTBUSH CIVIL SERVICES / LKM HAIRDESIGNS / QUORN RURAL SERVICES /
NUTRIEN AG SOLUTIONS BM 60 HANDICAP - 1400 Metres

EXONUMIA (J. Gutte) - rider was reprimanded under AR131(b) for failing to ride her mount out to the finish with sufficient vigour.

INNER SANCTUM (S. Terachi) - slow to begin. Shifted out under pressure in the straight.

RAW GRUNT (A. Stone) - rider explained that the gelding hung in for the majority of the event and proved difficult to ride out in the straight.

Correct weight for this event was delayed to allow S. Terachi (INNER SANCTUM) to view the vision of the start.

RACE 4: SPORTSBET / BA CORE / CARLING FUEL / IGA QUORN RATING 0 - 52 HANDICAP -
1400 Metres

AUGUSTA ROCK (J. Kerr) - laid out rounding the home turn. Laid in under pressure in the straight.

HAMILTON BROWN (A. Stone) - rider explained that the gelding was disappointing when placed under pressure in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

COWLEY'S CREEK (S. Terachi) - hampered at the start when bumped by SENGOKI.



RACE 4: SPORTSBET / BA CORE / CARLING FUEL / IGA QUORN RATING 0 - 52 HANDICAP - 1400 Metres (cont'd)

SENGOKI (W. Cave) - jumped away awkwardly and shifted out onto COWLEY'S CREEK.

ZILZIE LAD (NZ) (M. Henderson) - as there was no other rider available, Stewards permitted M. Henderson to ride the gelding 1.5kg over its allotted weight.

SCANDALIST (A. Stead) - as there was no other rider available, Stewards permitted A. Stead to ride the mare 1.5kg over its allotted weight. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

RACE 5: HEM QUORN CUP - 1900 Metres

ROMANS LUCK (J. Gutte) - laid in under pressure in the straight.

OVERLOADED (J. Kerr) - raced wide without cover throughout the event.

GHEMME (M. Henderson) - as there was no other rider available, Stewards permitted M. Henderson to ride the mare 1.5kg over its allotted weight. Shortly after the start bumped with CARASHAN CHLOE.

TITAN RISING (S. Wright) - difficult to load. Trainer, Mr D. Page, was advised that a warning had been placed on the gelding. Laid out under pressure in the straight.

CARASHAN CHLOE (A. Stone) - shortly after the start bumped with GHEMME. Rider explained that the mare failed to muster early speed. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

LETTEMGO (W. Cave) - passing the 1600m improved onto the heels of STAR DECORUM and had to be steadied.

STAR DECORUM (S. Terachi) - jumped away awkwardly. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Passing the 1600m improved onto the heels of LITTLE OUTLAW and had to be steadied.

LITTLE OUTLAW (A. Stead) - as there was no other rider available, Stewards permitted A. Stead to ride the gelding 1.5kg over its allotted weight. Made the turn near the 1600m awkwardly.

RACE 6: AUSTRAL INN, QUORN / JENLAMAR / GLANVILLE HOTEL / HAWKER ROADHOUSE RATING 0 - 52 HANDICAP - 1100 Metres

SHIKANIC (M. Henderson) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to have bled from both nostrils. Trainer, Mr P. Nolan, was advised that as this was the gelding's first bi-lateral bleed SHIKANIC would now be suspended from racing for a period of three months in accordance with AR79(4) and would be required to have the gelding reinstated in accordance with AR79(4)(b) prior to a future race.

HEDGED YOUR BETS (W. Cave) - near the 1000m shifted in onto SACRED CHORD, resulting in that gelding having to be steadied. Passing the 1000m shifted out abruptly in an attempt to maintain a position outside of LORD MORTON. Rider was reminded of his obligations under AR131(a) to ensure that he was sufficiently clear prior to shifting ground.

SACRED CHORD (J. Gutte) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination on arrival on course as it had raced at Murray Bridge on Wednesday, 12 August 2026 and was deemed suitable to start. Steadied near the 1000m when SACRED CHORD shifted in.

SEA TREASURES (NZ) (A. Stone) - rider explained that the gelding felt uncomfortable in its action. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the off foreleg (3/5). First aid administered. Trainer, Mr P. Nolan, was advised that a Veterinary Clearance would be required prior to a future jump-out, trial or race start.
