RACE 1: ROADSIDE SERVICES AND SOLUTIONS MAIDEN PLATE - 2050 Metres

KELORIK (J. Holder) - began awkwardly. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding had bled from both nostrils. First aid administered. Trainer, Mr S. Gower, was advised that as this was the gelding's first bi-lateral bleed KELORIK would now be suspended from racing for a period of three months in accordance with AR79(4) and would be required to have the gelding reinstated in accordance with AR79(4)(b) prior to a future race.

SHAMASTAR (T. Pannell) - raced keenly for the majority of the event. Rider reported that while it had been his intention to lead as had been the gelding's recent racing pattern, when the gelding was pressured slightly early SHAMASTAR commenced to over-race and continued to do so thereafter.



RACE 1: ROADSIDE SERVICES AND SOLUTIONS MAIDEN PLATE – 2050 Metres (cont'd)

BLABBER MOUTH (R. Milnes) – rider could offer no explanation for the filly's performance. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities. Co-trainer, Mr R. Jolly, advised Stewards on Tuesday, 9 June, that the stable vet had attended the horse with no issues detected and it would now be the stable's intention to send the filly for a short freshen up.

LADY DEEDS (T. Voorham) – began awkwardly. Held up for a short distance passing the 400m.

RACE 2: SPORTSBET JOCKEY WATCH MAIDEN PLATE – 1100 Metres

SIR MONICA (A. Warren) – began awkwardly and was slow into stride. Inconvenienced near the 800m and had to be steadied. Over-raced for some distance thereafter.

ANOTHERLIABILITY (B. King) – as no senior riders were available Stewards permitted apprentice B. King to ride the gelding. Began awkwardly. Trainer, Mr J. Macmillan, was unable to provide any explanation for the gelding's performance; however, stated that connections would consider ANOTHERLIABILITY's immediate future and consider a spell. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

NO BAIL (T. Voorham) – shifted in near the 800m and inconvenienced SIR MONICA. Rider was reprimanded under AR131(a) for careless riding. In considering the matter Stewards considered the racing manners of SIR MONICA, which had been racing keenly leading into the incident, and determined they played a part in exacerbating the incident.

PLATINO (T. Pannell) – laid out under pressure in the straight and hung out approaching the winning post.

GARRISON MISS (L. Stojakovic) – following the declaration of acceptances co-trainer, Mr S. Oxlade, made a gear application to add a tongue-tie to the filly's race gear. Stewards acceded to this request and acting under AR206(2) fined Mr Oxlade \$100. In considering the matter Stewards noted Mr Oxlade's excellent record in relation to this rule. Raced wide throughout the event.

GLITZY GOLDEN GIRL (T. Johnstone) – laid out under pressure in the straight.

RACE 3: SPORTSBET SAME RACE MULTI MAIDEN PLATE – 1100 Metres

LUNA PHASE (B. King) – began awkwardly. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

EXTRA FLING (T. Pannell) – near the 800m shifted in and tightened GO ASK ALICE onto HERE SHE IS, which had to be steadied. Rider was reprimanded under AR131(a). Laid out under pressure in the straight.

INFECTED (S. Potter) – laid out rounding the home turn.

GOODLOOKIN' GURU (J. Holder) – laid out rounding the turn near the 800m. Under pressure from the 500m. Rider reported that the filly raced greenly throughout the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

HERE SHE IS (K. Crowther) – crowded approaching the 800m and inside the 800m was tightened and had to be steadied.

GO ASK ALICE (T. Johnstone) – shifted in near the 800m and tightened HERE SHE IS, and was then taken in by EXTRA FLING further tightening HERE SHE IS.

WINGS OF DESTINY (T. Voorham) – slow into stride.



RACE 4: SPORTSBET SET A DEPOSIT LIMIT MAIDEN PLATE – 1350 Metres

GOLDFIELDS GREY (K. Crowther) – raced wide near the rear of the field in the early stages of the event before being permitted to stride forward near the 800m and taking up a forward position near the 600m.



RACE 4: SPORTSBET SET A DEPOSIT LIMIT MAIDEN PLATE - 1350 Metres (cont'd)

ME NAME'S BORIS (C. Murtagh) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed a slower than expected recovery.

VANINETTI (B. King) - shifted out marginally near the 800m. Held up for a short distance near the 400m before shifting to the inside of other runners.

KAPPA (T. Pannell) - bumped TOAST FOR BECKY at the start. Raced keenly in the early stages of the event. Raced ungenerously approaching the 800m, shifted in and bumped VANINETTI, then shifted out across the heels of GOLDFIELDS GREY, which shifted in marginally. Continued to lay out thereafter. Trainer, Mr M. Hickmott, was advised that a warning had been placed on the gelding.

BLUE HORIZON (NZ) (A. Goindasamy) - began awkwardly. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

KARMA QUEEN (R. Milnes) - laid out under pressure in the straight.

TOAST FOR BECKY (W. Cave) - bumped with KAPPA on jumping away. Improved onto heels near the 600m and had to be eased. Held up for clear running from approaching the 500m until near the 400m.

RACE 5: SPORTSBET FAST FORM MAIDEN PLATE - 1350 Metres

MOUSSAKA (NZ) (J. Holder) - crowded on jumping away and then tightened between PAGANINI and DARCI LANE (NZ) and had to be steadied. Raced keenly in the middle stages of the event. Taken wider by ANDREFI near the 600m. Held up for clear running from near the 600m until the 350m.

PAGANINI (C. Tootell) - shifted in and bumped MOUSSAKA (NZ) on jumping away. Inconvenienced near the 1000m. Raced wide throughout the event. Rider explained that being caught wide was detrimental to the gelding's performance. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

VAMORE (NZ) (T. Voorham) - shifted in near the 1000m and inconvenienced PAGANINI. Rider was severely reprimanded under AR131(a) for careless riding.

DARCI LANE (NZ) (T. Pannell) - began awkwardly, shifted out and bumped MOUSSAKA (NZ). Raced keenly in the middle stages of the event. Laid in under pressure in the straight.

TOOK GARDNER (A. Warren) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Over-raced near the 800m when being restrained to obtain cover.

CRIMSON WALTZ (A. Goindasamy) - began awkwardly. Held up for clear running from the 500m until the 400m. Again momentarily held up for clear running on entering the straight.

ANDREFI (T. Johnstone) - bucked shortly after the start. Trainer, Mr P. Stokes, was advised that the filly would now be required to prove tractable in an Official Barrier Trial prior to a future race start. Shifted wider near the 600m taking MOUSSAKA (NZ) wider on the track. Rider was reminded of her obligations to ensure she was sufficiently clear prior to shifting ground. Held up for clear running from the 500m until the 350m.

OR AM I (W. Price) - laid out under pressure in the straight. Rider explained that in his opinion the filly would prefer a more rain affected track and an increase in distance. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

PRANCING FOOL (B. King) - fractious on leaving the mounting yard and dislodged its rider. Co-trainers, Mr P. and Mrs B. Blanch, were advised that a warning had been placed on the filly. Began awkwardly. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.



RACE 6: ADELAIDE GALVANISING INDUSTRIES CLASS ONE HANDICAP - 1100 Metres

PRECIPICE (NZ) (J. Holder) - improved onto heels near the 800m and was momentarily steadied.

SHOCAP (H. Grace) – raced keenly throughout the event.

JE CITY (S. Potter) – began awkwardly and shifted in. Raced wide throughout the event.

HAVILAH (S. Metcalfe) – laid out under pressure in the straight.

HEAT OF THE NIGHT (D. Caboche) – tightened on jumping away.

MALDIVICA (T. Voorham) – rider explained that the filly may not have appreciated the soft track conditions. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

CHILLI CRAB (T. Pannell) – rider explained that the mare may not have appreciated the soft track conditions. Trainer advised on Tuesday, 9 June 2026 that the mare had pulled up well, was better suited to firmer tracks, and would derive fitness benefit from this first up run.

MISS SGHIRRIPA (L. Stojakovic) – began awkwardly and shifted out. Rider reported that after beginning only fairly from the wide barrier she had elected to obtain a position with cover near the inside running rail, rather than press forward to take up a forward position as is the filly's usual racing pattern.

RACE 7: ADELAIDE HILLS GAS RATING 0 - 58 HANDICAP – 2050 Metres

UNITED LEGEND (T. Pannell) – began awkwardly and shifted out. Laid out under pressure in the straight.

IRLANDAIS (A. Jordsjo) – shifted in near the 1700m when insufficiently clear of BLUE ISLES. Rider was reprimanded under AR131(a) for careless riding. Rider reported that it was not her intention to settle in such a prominent position; however, after beginning well and racing keenly in the early stages she permitted her mount to stride forward.

RIKKI RIKKARDO (C. Murtagh) – began awkwardly and shifted out. Raced keenly in the early stages of the event when being restrained in an attempt to gain cover. Held up for clear running approaching the 500m before shifting out inside the 400m and momentarily inconvenienced RETOURNE (NZ). Rider was advised he would be required to take greater care when shifting ground in future.

BUSH INFERENCE (J. Holder) – bumped with FIORENTE SPRITZ on jumping away.

RETOURNE (NZ) (D. Tourneur) – began awkwardly. Became momentarily awkward on the heels of RIKKI RIKKARDO inside the 400m.


WARRANTYTE ROAD (S. Potter) – raced wide without cover throughout the event. Became momentarily awkward on the heels of IRLANDAIS, which laid out approaching the 50m.

JACKSON RUN (T. Hutchinson) – began awkwardly, shifted out and was momentarily held up for clear running inside the 400m. Laid out under pressure in the straight. Raced wide for the majority of the event.

BLUE ISLES (W. Price) – was momentarily inconvenienced near the 1700m when IRLANDAIS shifted in. Raced wide for the majority of the event. Laid in under pressure in the straight.

FIORENTE SPRITZ (M. Collett) – underwent a pre-race veterinary examination on arrival on course as it had raced in the previous seven days and was deemed suitable to start. Shifted out and bumped with BUSH INFERENCE on jumping away.

AMERICAN TROUBLE (L. Stojakovic) – lost a plate in the tie-ups pre-race. As the mare was unable to be replated Stewards permitted AMERICAN TROUBLE to race bare behind. Improved onto heels and had to be steadied near the 1900m.



STAR STUDDED BELLE (J. Doyle) – became momentarily awkward on heels shortly after the start. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the mare to have a persistent cough. Co-trainers, Mr J. Hickmott and Ms C. Riggs, were advised that a Veterinary Clearance including the results of an endoscope would be required prior to a future jump-out, trial or race start.



RACE 8: PESTKA SIGNS RATING 0 - 56 HANDICAP - 1600 Metres

HALLSTATT (D. Caboche) - raced keenly near the 900m.

FLYWAY (D. Tourneur) - raced keenly near the 900m.

MORLAIX (R. Milnes) - rider reported that the mare raced flat when placed under pressure and in her opinion may be at the end of its preparation. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities. Trainer, Mr S. Padman, advised on Tuesday, 9 June 2026 that the mare pulled up well, was better suited when able to be ridden off the pace; however, would now go for a spell.

FINE ACE (J. Doyle) - began awkwardly. Raced wide in the early stages of the event until it was permitted to stride forward near the 1300m to obtain the lead and a position near the running rail near the 800m. Shifted in and bumped with CHARTIN (NZ) on entering the straight.

CANYON WIND (B. King) - raced wide in the early stages of the event prior to being permitted to stride forward near the 1300m to take up a leading position near the inside running rail near the 800m. Obligated to take hold and lost its position approaching the 400m when MAGIC PRINCESS shifted out.

GEETEE FORTY (C. Tootell) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Over-raced near the 900m. Held up for clear running from the 500m until inside the 400m.

MAGIC PRINCESS (T. Voorham) - raced keenly in the back straight. Shifted out to improve approaching the 400m when insufficiently clear of CANYON WIND, which had to be steadied and lost its position. Rider pleaded guilty to a charge of careless riding under AR131(a) and was suspended from riding in races for a period to commence at midnight Wednesday, 10 June 2026 to conclude midnight Saturday, 20 June 2026 - a period of three meetings.

CRADLE OF JAZZ (A. Stead) - held up for clear running rounding the home turn. Improved onto heels near the 400m and had to be steadied.

LADY LUPARA (NZ) (S. Metcalfe) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination on arrival on course and was deemed suitable to start.

CHARTIN (NZ) (T. Johnstone) - raced keenly near the 900m. Held up for clear running from the 500m until inside the 400m. Shifted out and bumped FINE ACE entering the home straight before shifting in and bumping with GEETEE FORTY soon after. Dislodged its rider on return to scale.

GUMERACHA CRACKER (W. Price) - tightened near the 1500m and made the crossing awkwardly. Rider explained that in his opinion the mare may not have appreciated today's track condition. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 9: VICTOR HARBOR MOTOR CO RATING 0 - 56 HANDICAP - 1200 Metres

DOUGAL MCKEEN (NZ) (M. Collett) - momentarily raced in restricted room near the 800m.

FASHION DOG (T. Hutchinson) - began awkwardly and shifted out and away from heels soon after. Over-raced between the 1000m and 900m and raced keenly thereafter. Rider was obliged to take hold when racing keenly and tightened AEECEE SUPREME approaching the 400m.

UNCLE BARRY (NZ) (W. Price) - began awkwardly and shifted out. Laid in rounding the home turn, shifted in slightly and tightened AEECEE SUPREME near the 400m despite the efforts of its rider.

ARAMOSO (C. Murtagh) - raced keenly in the early stages when being restrained to obtain a position with cover nearer the inside running rail. Shifted in slightly under pressure approaching the winning post and tightened FULL COMMITMENT. Rider was advised to exercise greater care in similar circumstances in future.

HAZY DAZE (B. King) - bumped with FLYIN' FOR US on jumping away.

FLYIN' FOR US (D. Caboche) - bumped with HAZY DAZE on jumping away. Bumped with DODD soon after.

RACE 9: VICTOR HARBOR MOTOR CO RATING 0 - 56 HANDICAP - 1200 Metres (cont'd)

IT'S ONLY MAGIC (A. Warren) - laid out marginally under pressure approaching the winning post and tightened FULL COMMITMENT. Rider was advised she would be required to exercise greater care when shifting ground in future.

ZENACITY (R. Milnes) - obliged to shift out and away from the heels of UNCLE BARRY (NZ) soon after the start. Laid out under pressure in the straight.

FULL COMMITMENT (H. Grace) - obliged to momentarily steady when racing in restricted room approaching the winning post.

AEECEE SUPREME (D. Tourneur) - shifted out and bumped DODD shortly after the start. Was momentarily tightened and shifted in approaching the 400m.

DODD (L. Stojakovic) - bumped with AEECEE SUPREME shortly after the start, then bumped with FLYIN' FOR US.

GENERAL:

Co-trainer, Mr D. Koch, was reprimanded under AR102(a) for failing to lodge a stable return reflecting that LUNA PHASE had been gelded. In considering the matter Stewards noted that the gelding procedure had occurred prior to LUNA PHASE having its first race start.
