

Racing SA Ltd Stipendiary Stewards' Report

Report on Race Meeting held at Streaky Bay
Racecourse by the Streaky Bay Racing Club on
Saturday, 21 March 2026

TRACK: Good/Dirt (More loosened surface than fast, some kickback may be evident)

RAIL: True.

WEATHER: Fine

RACE 1: CHRIS GEORGIU BUILDING MAIDEN PLATE - 1000 Metres

PRINCESS NOW (T. Hutchinson) - laid in under pressure in the straight.

RACE 2: LETCHER AND MORONEY CHARTERED ACCOUNTANTS/ YOUR FINANCIAL EDGE
BENCHMARK 62 HANDICAP - 1000 Metres

THE STREAKER (A. Goindasamy) - rider explained that the gelding travelled well in the early and middle stages of the event; however, when placed under pressure did not respond to his riding and was disappointing. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

PARACHUTER (L. Stojakovic) - slow to begin.

BONJOUR (NZ) (C. Munro) - slow to begin. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to have bled from both nostrils. Co-trainers, Mr T. and Mrs L. Allen, were advised that as this was the gelding's second bi-lateral bleed it was now ineligible to start in a race in accordance with AR79(6).

RACE 3: MORGANS FINANCIAL BENCHMARK 54 HANDICAP - 1200 Metres

HERE COMES HOGAN (A. Goindasamy) - rider explained that after jumping away awkwardly the gelding stumbled and was disappointing under pressure. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

PRESCIENT (C. Munro) - hung out rounding the home turn and under pressure in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SAMANTH (J. Gutte) - jumped away awkwardly.

RACE 4: STREAKY BAY HOTEL 3H, SPORTSBET & QUALITY WOOL BENCHMARK 62
HANDICAP - 1350 Metres

CHEF MILITAIRE (A. Webb) - rider reported that the gelding hung out over the concluding stages of the event.

TORETTO (P. Brewster) - slow to begin. Rider reported that the gelding never travelled throughout the event.

RACE 4: STREAKY BAY HOTEL 3H, SPORTSBET & QUALITY WOOL BENCHMARK 62
HANDICAP - 1350 Metres (cont'd)

ROYAL TRAPEZE (A. Goindasamy) - rider explained that the gelding hung in under pressure in the straight and proved difficult to ride. Trainer, Mr S. Theodore, was advised that a warning had been placed on the gelding.

ARCHDEACON (A. Jordsjo) - A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 5: XXXX GOLD & STREAKY BAY COMMUNITY HOTEL STREAKY BAY CUP (HEAT 7
EYRE PENINSULA LEGENDS SERIES)- 1800 Metres

EVERLASTING KISS (P. Brewster) - near the 1550m had to be steadied when SHAKESPEARE (NZ) rolled in.

SHAKESPEARE (NZ) (C. Munro) - near the 1550m rolled in marginally onto EVERLASTING KISS. Raced wide without cover throughout the event.

GALLOPING GURU (NZ) (S. Terachi) - rider accidentally dropped his whip near the 400m.

BOOM BANG (A. Goindasamy) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Laid out under pressure in the straight. Rider accidentally dropped his whip near the 300m.

EXPLICABLE (T. Hutchinson) - reared as the start was affected and lost considerable ground. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities. Trainer, Mr G. Lynch, was advised that a warning had been placed on the gelding.

RACE 6: CONTECT ELECTRICAL RATING 0 - 54 HANDICAP - 1800 Metres

STARDEALT (P. Brewster) - rider reported that the gelding did not appreciate the kick-back in today's event.

LICHESTER (NZ) (S. Terachi) - rider was reprimanded under AR132(6)(c) for using his whip when his mount was out of contention. Rider explained that the mare was unbalanced for the majority of the event and changed lead legs rounding the turns. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the mare to be lame in the near foreleg (1/5). Trainer, Mr T. Haddy, was advised that a Veterinary Clearance would be required prior to a future jump-out, trial or race start.

FLYING STEP (A. Webb) - jumped away awkwardly.

FOX DUNNETT (T. Hutchinson) - jumped away awkwardly and was slow to begin.

GENERAL:

Trainer, Mr G. Lynch, was fined \$500 under LR11.4.4 for providing incorrect information when notifying Racing SA Integrity department of his horse's travel arrangements.

RIDER SAMPLING:

All eleven (11) riders provided a breathalyser and saliva sample prior to their first ride and all returned negative results.

Three (3) riders provided urine samples: A. Webb, J. Gutte, T. Hutchinson.
